Hunter trials Entry fee \$100 inclusive of all additional SEC GF & PCAWA start levy, which allows a maximum of 2 rounds per horse/rider combination.

Hickstead entry fee is \$80 inclusive of all additional SEC GF & PCAWA start levy. which allows a maximum of 2 rounds per horse/rider combination. One horse and rider combination must choose either Hunter trials or Hickstead - they cannot do both.

Tetrathlon and Equathon entry fee is \$100 for individual, \$100 for a tetrathlon team (50% discount if also competing as an individual) and \$45 to do a second hight round at the Hunter Trials/Hickstead.

Please note that only 2 rounds per horse/rider combination are permitted.

Please note that Global Entries Online requires immediate payment of entries. If you haven't paid, you're not entered and if it's not asking for payment you have entered incorrectly.

The Tetrathlon and Equathon classes will run under current PCWA Tetrathlon Rules 2020.

Entering this event constitutes implicit acceptance of the PCWA rules. Horses must be at least 4 years of age to compete in a PCWA Event and riders must be 8 years as of 1st January 2023 for classes 22-23 and 29-30 and at least 6 years of age as of 1st January 2023 for classes 31-33 and 36-37.

All competitors are ultimately responsible for knowing these rules and complying with them. PCWA gear checking rules apply. Details of these rules can be found at the following web sites:

Please note: Coloured Jodhpurs are allowed at this event, all other PCWA gear checking rules apply.

Cross Country Course – The Course is situated on the plains of the Swan River and includes both permanent and transportable type fences.

There is a water complex and good open grassed country for galloping.

The 80cm, 65cm & 45cm are very encouraging for young or inexperienced horse and rider combinations and the 95cm is quite challenging.

*Hickstead classes are in an enclosed arena.

Please note that classes may be combined or split depending on the number of entries we receive.

Note: Class sizes will be limited and classes will close when full.

Please note: Your entry enables you to ride two rounds with the same horse/rider combination: -

How to enter - Hunter Trials

Choose an **age** class either Class 2, 4, 7, 9, 12, 14, 16, 19, 21 or 23 for your preferred height: generally run in the morning and is set by the age/category of rider. (Only one class per horse & rider combination is allowed these classes).

Choose a second round **height** class between **Classes 25-30**: set by the height of the horse for no extra charge. (Only one class per horse & rider combination is allowed in classes 25-30).

When entering Hunter trials please select one age round either Class 2, 4, 7, 9, 12, 14, 16, 19, 21 or 23 and then one round in classes 25-30.

How to enter Hickstead

When Entering Hickstead please select **one round**, **either class 31**, **33 or 35** (an age class) and **one round in class 36-39** (a pony height class).

How to enter – Tetrathlon and Equathon

Choose an **individual** class either **Class 1, 3, 6, 8, 11, 13, 15, 18, 20 or 22** for your preferred height. (Only one class per horse & rider combination is allowed these classes).

If you would like to do a second round, choose a second round **height** class between **Classes 25-30**: set by the height of the horse for \$45. (Only one class per horse & rider combination is allowed in classes 25-30).


If you would like to enter a team for Tetrathlon, choose a **team** class either **Class 5, 10, 17 or 24** for your preferred height. Only the team manager selects the class and pays the \$100 entry fee for the whole team (Cost split is riding phase \$40, all other phases \$20 if the team members wish to share costs). Details of other team members can be entered in the questions section. If riders have also selected an individual round, this counts for the team score also. If other team members have competed as individuals, the team cost is reduced by 50%. Teams can consist of minimum 2 and maximum 4 competitors.

If you are currently not a pony club member, you can still join a tetrathlon team by signing up as a non-riding day member. Please see the following information for additional instructions if required.


