CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The organisers/committee of Dryandra Regional Equestrian Association (DREA) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they seem necessary on the day.
2. All riders must wear a current approved safety helmet (as per EA rules) and riding boots at all times when mounted on their horse/pony.
3. Riders must wear neat tidy attire. Hacking jackets and plaiting are OPTIONAL but encouraged, Adult Riders and Pony Club uniforms allowed.
4. All Leading Rein handlers must wear closed in footwear & ponies must be led by a single lead attached at the back of a cavesson nose band. No halters or leads with chains attached are to be used. Riders competing in the lead line classes are not permitted in the other ridden classes
5. Rider's age will be as at the day of the event, proof of age may be requested.
6. Ponies must be 14hh or under to compete in the Pony Ring, No galloways/horses are permitted in the lead line ring.
7. DREA reserves the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.
8. DREA and its committee, judges and officials DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the DREA grounds is at your own risk.
9. If you are not a direct member of DREA or DPC the \$30 day insurance to be submitted with entry.
10. NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.
11. No stallions or colts permitted
12. Competitors are only allowed to compete in one in hand and one ridden ring. Horses/ponies are only allowed to compete in either a walk/trot class OR walk/trot/canter class – not both.
13. No Judge is to be approached at any time by a competitor or spectator without speaking to a DREA committee member first.
14. Strictly NO double bridles, martingales, or spurs allowed. Bitless bridles permitted however no rope halter or hackamore types (as per ARCA rules and EA rules).
15. This is an ENCOURAGEMENT show, as such in the spirit of this, Official Horses and Ponies will not be eligible to compete unless being ridden/handled by young/new/inexperienced riders (not Official Riders or ones very close to being so). Official Horses and Ponies will be defined as those who are current SHC or EA Show Horses (or other relevant official registration/membership board) or have been current in the past 2 years (since Jan 2021) OR have competed in the official ring within the last 2 years (Since January 2021). Official Riders will have the same definition as Official Horses/Ponies however can participate if they are riding a green/young horse.
16. There will be an early Lunch break of 45 minutes in between the in-hand and ridden classes (approx. 11 – 11:45 with ridden classes starting from 11:45 or later depending on when in-hand classes finish).
17. OTT High Point Thoroughbreds and Standardbreds Awarded based on "points" throughout the day.

1st place - 4 points

Champion – 4

2nd place - 3 points

Reserve Champion - 3

3rd place - 2 point

Disclaimer Acknowledgement

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that.

- Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.
- There is a significant risk that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from horse sport activities.
- I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.
- I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activities and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse sports activities.
- I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the activities and my immediate removal from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur.
- I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability as a result of my failure to comply.
- I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations, and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that whilst participating I wear a suitable helmet at all times where required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations, and take sole responsibility for my actions.
- I have had sufficient opportunity to read this assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms and sign it freely and voluntarily.
- I agree to abide by any and all Western Australian requirements in regards to COVID19 and acknowledge that these may change with limited notice prior to the event.

For Participants of Minority Age (Under Age 18)

This is to certify that I, as a parent/guardian with legal responsibility for any participants under the age of 18 on this registration, acknowledge, understand and accept and consent and agree to my minor child's involvement or participation in horse sport activities.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that the organizing committee has to cancel the event close to the date, once significant expenditure has been incurred, refunds will not necessarily be given. The Organizing Committee will do their best to return as much as possible from entry fees remaining after expenses.

Participants who cancel before the entry close date/time (5pm 24th April 2023) will receive a full refund minus an administration fee of \$15. No refund will apply for entries after 5pm 24th April 2023 including those done after late entries open.
