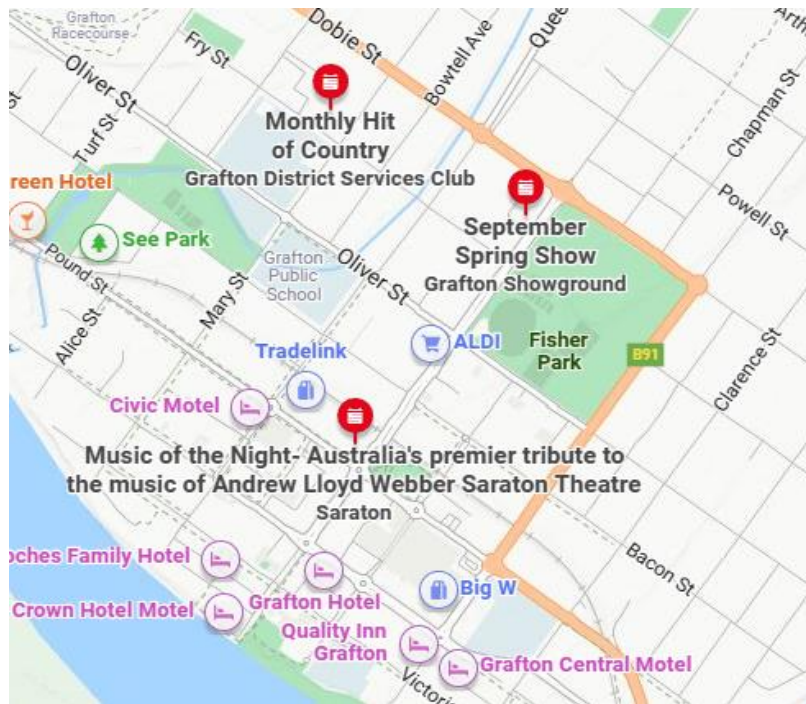

## **Rules and Conditions of Entry:**

### **All events are run under EA Australia and FEI Rules**

- All riders competing at the event MUST be a member of Equestrian Australia.
- All Horses & riders competing in 1.05 and over must hold a competition license with their respective states.
- All horses in events 1.04 cm and under must have a base registration with their respective states and owners be members of equestrian Australia to compete. This is requirement of all competitions as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2023
- **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au)** and must be paid within 40 minutes of entry being submitted. Entries not paid at this time are automatically deleted by the system.
- **ALL Stables and camping** are to be paid for before arrival. All stables are to be paid for before use and to be left clean and tidy a stable bond of \$30 per stall will be charged and refunded via the entry portal, once inspected. Your own yards are encouraged but must meet EA standards (no Electrical tape)
- Please ensure that your details including contact information, horse and rider EA numbers and PIC numbers are up to date in Global entries. **HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION MUST BE FILLED OUT AND COMPLETED NO EXCEPTIONS. This is Grafton showground policy.**
- **Warm up arena rules apply no more than 4 horses warming up and the check in with marshal prior to warm up. White board draw will be followed and ring 1 has priority.**
- You can only choose one class, A or B class.
- JUNIOR CLASSES ARE ONLY FOR Under 18 years.
- Adult classes are for rider 18 years and over.
- Any disputes must be made within 30 mins of class and \$50 nonrefundable fee will be charged.
- **THOROUGHBRED SPORT HORSE ASSOCIATION - To be eligible to enter TSHA classes your horse must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book, have a microchip number and a TSHA competition license. TSHA competition licenses can be purchased on Global Entries by logging in and going to the 'Manage Horses' page. - The VRSIC Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule as deemed necessary, including combining classes with insufficient entries as well as refuse entries as per Equestrian Australia rules.
- It is on the onus that competitors follow and understand the rules put in place.
- Riders must wear correct attire and regulation dress. Jackets are to be worn unless the Judge announces summer dress.
- Headwear is compulsory in both jumping and practice arena and must comply with the current Standards as stated in the Equestrian Australia rules and must be tagged to compete. The club has tags available.

- All refunds will be done via this platform, refunds will only be with a vet certificate or doctors' certificate via email & 50% will be refunded upon this being approved Prior to close of entries. After close of entries minus 20 % with vet certificate or medical certificate. Please don't ask unless you have sufficient documents.

- Dogs – if you bring them – please make sure that they always remain on a lead and tethered, and adhere to Grafton showground policies- NO DOGS in RING while jumping is on NO prams in ring while jumping is in play (this is Grafton showground policy)
- Horses can have 3 starts per day under 1.05 horses jumping over 1.05 are limited to 2 starts per day.
