- Class 4b, 5b, 6b, 11b, 12b and 13b are only TSHA Licence Horses

- Competitor may only compete once in each class 2a or 2b, 4a or 4b, 5a or 5b, 6a or 6b, 9a or 9b, 11a or 11b, 12a or 12b and 13a or 13b

- All entries must be lodged and paid for on [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au) by the dates specified, this includes payment, registration for all riders and horses.

- Show waivers are to be completed online with entries. (under "Important Documents") and emailed me to [centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com](mailto:centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com)

- Horse Health Declaration form is to be completed online with entries or before arriving at venue (under "Important Documents") and emailed to [centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com](mailto:centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com).

#### **Late changes & Live Editing:**

- Late changes for classes must be made by competitors via "Live Editing" in their Global Entries event registration at least the day prior to the class they wish to change or enter.

- Live editing will be open from 7am – 10am after entries have closed or please see Showjumping Office (next to arena)

#### **Camping/Yards**

Competitors may set up portable yards must be a minimum of 3 metres x 3 metres and be of safe and solid construction. Limited yards available please contact Clinton Hedger – [centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com](mailto:centralwestshowjumping@gmail.com)

#### **Refunds:**

- A 95% refund will be given for scratching's before the closing date

- After the closing date, an 80% refund will be given only on sighting a doctors or veterinary certificate.

## Regulations

1. Canowindra PA & H Association is a member of the ASC, affiliated with EA (NSW) Inc. This event is conducted under the EA & FEI rules.
2. Current EA horse and rider registrations must be supplied for all official class entries
3. All Riders & Owners must be financial members of the EA and all horses must hold current EA registration and Jumping Licenses to compete in Official Classes and registration numbers must be entered in global entries online on entries
4. Juniors: calendar year they turn 8yrs until calendar year they turn 17 yrs.
- 5a. Australian helmet standards will apply. All riders must wear an approved helmet whilst mounted at all times and have appropriate footwear.
- 5b. Helmet Tagging for AgShows- All equestrian (EA) Affiliated shows do need to have helmets tagged for Showjumping.
6. Riders are required to wear correct attire in all classes. (Saturday & Sunday)
7. Any outstanding payments for entries and bookings must be made before commencement of the first class the rider is entered in on that day
8. No dogs allowed in the main, practice or jumping arenas at any time.
9. Show jumping arenas and practice arenas are to be used only by riders competing in the current competition
10. Six horses allowed in practice arena at any one time.
11. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the programme
12. Photos taken at this event maybe used for future publicity
13. Biosecurity - competitors should be aware that in the case of quarantine lockdown, the owner is responsible for his/her own and horse's welfare and all costs incurred.
14. Event Cancellation - If the event is cancelled prior to its commencement 90% of entry fees will be refunded.
