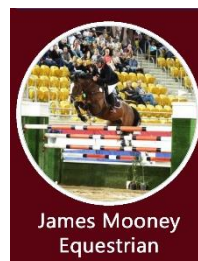
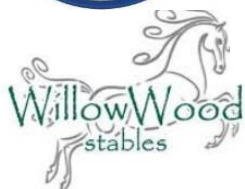

1. This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations. Including the following:
 - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
 - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
 - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d. EA Code of Conduct
Australian Helmet Standards
2. Australian Helmet Standards will apply. All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted, including presentations.
3. All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
4. After any fall anywhere at Stonewall, the rider must be cleared by the Medical Services Provider BEFORE re-mounting.
5. The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program, conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
6. The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
7. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
8. Draw Order – Ring One will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this. Ring 2 will be whiteboard.
9. Number of Starts:
 - a. A horse can have two starts in consecutive Classes.
 - b. Where there are concurrent classes (as in a,b,c sections), a rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class but on different horses.
10. Refunds: Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
11. Entry Changes
 - a. Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing
 - b. Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.
 - c. No HC entries allowed. Only 1 round per horse per class.
12. Presentation of Prizes – Prizes for each class will be awarded immediately following the event.
13. SCOOTERS – are allowed at Stonewall but riders must wear their riding helmets
14. Dogs & Prams
 - a. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
 - b. Dogs and prams are not allowed in the warm up or competition arenas
15. TSHA - All horses entering the thoroughbred classes must have a TSHA licence. TSHA licences can be purchased on Global Entries online. Log in to Global Entries and go to "manage horses" to fill in all details and pay for licence. If you need help, please contact Nicole Poetsch 0418 683 802 or info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au
16. Newcomers class - For competitors over 18 years where horse and rider have never started in a 1.30m class or higher and are not competing higher than 1.10m on any horse at this show
17. Junior class – Athletes can take part in Competitions for Juniors until the end of the calendar year, in which they reach the age of 18 years
18. Young Rider class – Athletes may take part in Competitions for Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21 years
19. Rider Under 25 years – Competitors may take part in this class until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 25 years
20. All riders and owners must be financial members of EA to compete in official Classes (1.05m and over). All horses competing in official Classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
21. GST – is included in all fees and charges and Prizemoney.
22. Prizemoney will be paid through Global Entries Online
