Horsemanship – an obstacle course

- About 10 obstacles (eg opening & closing a gate, jumping a small jump, bending poles, bridge etc)
- Open to all riders
- To take place from 11:00am onwards
- A map of the course will be displayed on the whiteboard at entrance of the course.

Clear Round Jumping:

- Starting height - x rails, 45cm, 60cm, 70cm, 80cm, 90cm.
- Limit of 2 rounds per horse. More rounds may be allowed on the day depending on the number of entries and if time permits.

Mini X/Country Course:

- This course is NOT for beginners. Heights - 60cm & 75cm.
- Riders must wear a back protector. Limit of 2 rounds per horse.

Conditions of Entry

1. For insurance purposes riders must be either a member of BRC or EA NSW. Non-members of BRC may join BRC for the Pink Ribbon Fun-khana by filling in the Event Membership Form. Event membership is \$10 per rider.
2. Entry payment by cash, cheque (payable to BRC) or direct deposit. A receipt of the direct deposit must be attached to the entry form before the entry will be accepted.

3. All riders compete at their own risk. Non-member of Berry Riding Club must sign a dangerous activity waiver and post it with the entry form. Members of BRC do not need to sign another waiver.
4. All riders must wear an approved helmet and correct riding boots whilst mounted.
5. Berry Riding Club Inc. accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to riders, horses, equipment or property.
6. The judge's decision is final.
7. The Committee of BRC Inc reserves the right to change the program on the day.
8. Definition of:

Novice: Rider/horse combination who haven't won a 1st place at an agricultural show or HOTY nor won a championship at a Pony Club gymkhana or Interschool in similar events, nor competed in Dressage higher than Preliminary. Must be able to walk, trot and canter in a controlled manner. Horse must be shown in a single rein bridle.

Beginners: Walk and trot only in Hack classes. However all riders may canter during the Horsemanship & show jumping rounds. The x/country course is not for beginners.

Riders will not be able to change rings on the day unless asked to do so by the judge.

9. **NB: A Class Schedule** will be emailed to all competitors just prior to the Fun-khana. It is very important that entries are not late. This Class Schedule will have the order of hacking classes & age groups in each Ring, the Championship Classes, a Volunteers timetable and any other necessary information.

This Fun-khana is a fundraiser for the National Breast Cancer Foundation (Pink Ribbon). The main aim of the day is to have lots of fun.

EVENT: (hereafter referred to as "EVENT(S)

NOTE: the Competition & Consumer Act 2010 ("the Act") implies a warranty of due care and skill into contracts for the supply of services to consumers, as defined in the Act. To the extent that the warranty applies to any contract relevant to the Release and Waiver of Liability, it cannot be excluded.

Subject to that warranty, if applicable and IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself/herself, his/her personal representatives, heirs and next of kin:

1. Acknowledges, agrees and represents that he/she further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he/she feels anything to be unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the officials of such and refuse to participate further in the EVENT(S).

2. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the club/coach, participants, EA and its state bodies or any subdivision thereof, officials, volunteers, medical personnel, any persons, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the EVENT(S), premises and event inspectors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes as herein referred to as "Releasees", FROM ALL LIABILITY, TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OR RELATED TO THE EVENT(S), WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
